Saturday, January 19, 2013
MADRID/AVILA

Arrive Madrid Airport and enjoy a panoramic city tour of the main attractions of Madrid and then we continue by bus to Avila, where we celebrate Holy Mass and then to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, January 20, 2013
AVILA

The ancient city of Avila looks much the same as it did during the Middle Ages. A giant wall formerly used as a protection against encroaching enemies still encircles the city. Within the walls of Avila we visit the Convent of St. Teresa (at Plaza de la Santa), the church that is the site of St. Teresa's birth. After Holy Mass, we visit the small museum that contains the relics of St. Teresa and St. John of the Cross. Outside the walls is the Monastery of Incarnation, where St. Teresa's cell can still be seen during our tour.

Monday, January 21, 2013
AVILA/ZARAGOZA/LOURDES

We depart Avila in the morning and drive towards Zaragoza to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of the Pilar, the second most popular pilgrimage site in Spain. The magnificent altar in the Basilica built on the site where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. James. After Mass, we continue our drive to Lourdes.

Tuesday, January 22 –
Thursday, January 24, 2013
LOURDES

During our stay in Lourdes, we will visit the historical and spiritual sites associated with Bernadette, the visionary child of Lourdes. We will take a walking tour of the Shrine, and the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground church.

We visit Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, the Cachot where the Soubirous family lived after losing their mill, the Parish Church, the Basilica of the Rosary and the Museum of St. Bernadette. We will walk the "Way of the Cross" and spend time in prayers, meditation, teaching and listening so we may grow in holiness.

Friday, January 25, 2013
LOURDES/NEVERS

This morning we say goodbye to Our Lady of Lourdes and drive towards Nevers. Upon arrival, we will celebrated Holy Mass and then visit the places associated with St. Bernadette. On the St. Gildard convent grounds lies the chapel containing the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. We see the museum with many historical documents; we walk the convent grounds and see the statue of Our Lady of Waters, Bernadette's favorite statue and replica of Lourdes Grotto.

Saturday, January 26, 2013
NEVERS/PARAY LE MONIAL

Today we continue our drive in France. Arrive Paray Le Monial where we celebrate Holy Mass and then visit shrine, home to the devotion of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We also visit the Chapel of the Visitation where Jesus exposed His Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Alacoque during a number of apparitions.

Sunday, January 27, 2013
PARAY LE MONIAL/LISIEUX

This morning we depart Paray Le Monial to Lisieux where we celebrate Holy Mass and then visit the places associated with St. Therese of Lisieux, the family home (Les Buissonets), the Carmelite Convent and the Basilica.

Monday, January 28, 2013

LISIEUX/MONT ST MICHEL/PARIS

Today we drive to the island-town of Mont St Michel with its picturesque streets and abbey. Mont-Saint-Michel is a shrine representing some of Catholicism's greatest artistic achievements. We will have a guided tour of the abbey and the museum and later continue to Paris.

Tuesday, January 29, 2013

PARIS

We will spend all day visiting Paris. We start with Mass at our Lady of the Miraculous Medal and then visit St. Vincent de Paul Chapel, the Cathedral of Notre Dame and the Sacred Heart Basilica with a beautiful view of the city of Paris. In the afternoon, we drive through Champs Elysees, the Triumphal Arch and we stop at Eiffel Tower for pictures. This evening, we will spend time of adoration at the Sacred Heart Basilica in Paris.

Wednesday, January 30, 2013

PARIS

Day at leisure in Paris. You may visit the Louvre Museum or a trip to Versailles Palace or enjoy walking on the Champs Elysees Blvd. This evening, we will have our farewell dinner followed by a cruise on the Seine River to see Paris "City of Lights" at night.
